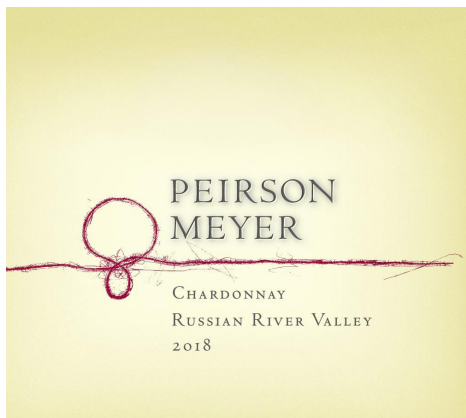
VINOUS Review

The 2018 Chardonnay (Russian River Valley) is a pretty exuberant, heady wine. Orange confit, hazelnut, butter and spice give this mid-weight Chardonnay tons of personality. Tropical and exotic, yet medium in body, the 2018 shows the more exuberant side of Russian River Chardonnay off to great effect.
