❖ One of Original Italian Families in the Dry Creek Valley

❖ Last in Dry Creek Valley to commercially use Mule in day to day farming – 1968

❖ Sourced from our 115-Year-Old Zinfandel Vines at Puccioni Ranch that were planted by our Great Grandfather and Grandfather

❖ Cold Soaked, Small Open Top Fermentation with Hand Punch down, 17 months in Hungarian and French Oak barrels. Blended with Petite Sirah from Puccioni Ranch

❖ Tasting Notes: Blackberry, blueberry, vanilla nose; plum, chocolate palate with balanced acidity and soft tannins; medium-plus finish.

❖ Alcohol 15.1%, TA .62, pH 3.69
