BODEGA

Bodega is surrounded by redwoods, wild flowers, coastal oaks and a beautiful assortment of plant life and native grasses. Hailing from just behind Bodega Bay near the town of Freestone this cool hillside site starts with a beautiful deep red core working its way to a brilliant ruby rim. Aromas of fresh cut wild strawberry, rose petals, coastal moss, and black raspberry lead to underlying notes of mint and crushed wet stone. On the palate the wine gives way to flavors of wild dark berries, gravel and salted mint. Bodega is backed with bright acidity and youthful, fine-grained tannins all leading to a wonderfully long finish.
