❖ Very limited production – 150 cases of hand crafted wine

❖ One of Original Italian Families in the Dry Creek Valley

❖ Last in Dry Creek Valley to commercially use Mule in day to day farming – 1968

❖ Sourced from our 117-Year-Old Zinfandel Vines at Puccioni Ranch that were planted by our Great Grandfather and Grandfather

❖ Cold Soaked, Small Open Top Fermentation with Hand Punch down, 18 months in Hungarian and French Oak barrels. Blended with Petite Sirah from Puccioni Ranch

❖ Tasting Notes: Deep berry/spice aromas, with layers of oak and rich dark fruit flavors balanced with black pepper spice.

❖ Alcohol 15.1%, TA .64, pH 3.68
