TASTING NOTES:

Peter Palmer: 2019 Bonaccorsi pinot noir, Santa Barbara County

Medium full, dark ruby red, with pink at the rim. Very fragrant right out of the bottle; showy, exotically perfumed nose of fresh raspberry, pomegranate, candied ginger, cardamom and radish. In the mouth, high toned, with candied watermelon, crystallized red fruits, parsnip and cool, snappy, minty herbs. Very pretty and extroverted, but deeply flavored as well. Bright, tart, red fruit finish
