2018 SEQUITUR PINOT NOIR "JACK"

THE SITE

The Sequitur vineyard is a 12- acre site that is directly adjacent to Beaux Frere's Upper Terrace in the Ribbon Ridge AVA, Willamette Valley, Oregon. It is owned by Michael Etzel (Beaux Freres) and his wife, Carey Critchlow and is part of their home estate. Half of the vineyard was planted in 2012 (the Lavender Block) and the other half in the spring of 2013 (the Rosemary Block). The vineyard is planted with 17 clones of Pinot Noir and a small knoll of Chardonnay and is surrounded on three sides by a forest of Douglas Fir. Sequitur has been farmed with biodynamic and organic practices since its inception.

TECHNICAL INFORMATION

Harvest: September 19-22, 2019

Vinification and aging: the grapes spent an average of 18 days in a mix of wood and stainless steel vats during primary fermentation with whole cluster used in some batches. The wine was then settled for a short period before being put into French oak barrels (25% new). Malolactic fermentation was complete on all lots in late April. The wine aged for ten months in barrel before being racked to tank in late July.
