2022 Freestone Occidental Bodega Vineyard Pinot Noir

"The 2022 Pinot Noir Bodega is the most exotic and dense of the three Raen Pinots. Black frui mocha, gravel, licorice and spice are all amplified in a Pinot that possesses tremendous densit and pure power. This quite muscular."

2022 Fort Ross-Seaview Sea Field Vineyard Pinot Noir

"Dark-toned fruit, spice leather, menthol and gravel infuse the 2022 with notable density and pure power. Like all the RAEN wines, the Sea Field was done with 100% whole clusters, but the stems are pretty much buried by the sheer intensity of the fruit."

2022 Sonoma Coast Royal St. Robert Cuvée Pinot Noir

"The 2022 Pinot Noir Royal St. Robert is striking. Vibrant and savory, the 2022 marries notable fruit intensity with strong floral, earthy and savory top notes. Bright red-toned fruit, orange peel, cinnamon, star anise and cedar lift from the glass. Deep and dense, yet also wonderfully crystalline, the 2022 is lights out. What a wine."

2022 Fort Ross-Seaview Charles Ranch Vineyard Chardonnay

"The 2022 Chardonnay Charles Ranch is sourced from vines planted in the early 1980s. Dried apricot, chamomile, tangerine oil, mint, hazelnut and dried flowers convey gorgeous floral and savory intensity. This is an especially old-school style of Chardonnay that emphasizes earthy and savory character more than primary fruit. It's one of the most complete, satisfying Chardonnays I have tasted so far from the 2022 vintage. Time in the glass brings out striking tropical presence and a good bit of grip that wraps it all together. Superb."

2022 Sonoma Coast Lady Marjorie Cuvée Chardonnay

"The 2022 Chardonnay Lady Marjorie is soft, open-knit and ready to drink. Apricot, tangerine peel and light tropical notes open nicely, framed by a discreet touch of oak that wraps it all together.
