Cold Soaked, Small Open Top Fermentation with Hand Punch down, 18 months in Hungarian Oak barrels

Tasting Notes: Blackberry/spice aroma, rich blueberry, berry syrup, and dark chocolate flavors, finishing with a black pepper spice and sweet tannins

Alcohol: 14.9% • TA: .63 • pH: 3.63
